The student must be slated to graduate on time and in good standing with the class of 2012. They must also have been accepted and be scheduled to begin classes by the fall of 2012 at an accredited college or trade school. Awards will be given based on the student's essay, academic performance, community involvement, and citizenship.

Awards will be determined solely by a private committee. No member of the Monticello School System will be on the committee, nor will they hold influence over it. The committee will not consider race, religion, creed, or gender. The decision of the committee is final – no appeal will be allowed or provided.
