Federal Pell Grant/William Ford Direct Loans

The school is eligible and participates in Federal Pell Grants and William D. Ford Direct Loans. Students must complete and ED approved financial aid application. Pell grant eligibility is determined by an assessment of the student, spouse or parent/ legal guardian's income and assets. Graduation & Licensing

Basic Cosmetology Course	1500 Clock Hrs
Instructor Course	600 Clock Hrs

To graduate from MHA each student must complete the recommended clock hours for the course of training and achieve a minimum of 75% on academic work and a satisfactory evaluation on all practical skills. Students must maintain a 70% average monthly attendance and fulfill all financial obligations to the school prior to graduation. Upon successful completion of the course, the student is awarded a diploma certifying training in all branches of cosmetology. The student is then registered for the Arkansas State Board licensing examination. *Students who have not completed their contracted hours by the contract date will have a fee of \$ 10.00 assessed for any and all additional hours.*

There is a \$20.00 registration fee for all courses due to the Arkansas State Board of Cosmetology which is the responsibility of the student. This fee is due prior to enrollment for the student permit. The student permit must be received before the student may attend class.
