

**The Centers for Youth and families has openings for the following;**

- **Teacher** for the 21-22 school year. Requirements include Bachelor's Degree in Education (Master's Degree preferred), Certified to teach through the Arkansas Board of Education, Eligible for certification in Special Education. Salary depends on experience.
- **RN's and LPN's** full-time and prn positions available – Requirements include: Valid AR nursing license, acceptable drug screen, acceptable background checks, valid AR driver's license and the ability to supervise staff. Nurses are responsible for dispensing medication and fulfilling all nursing duties assigned. Competitive salary and benefits. LPN's starting \$25-\$27 RN's \$35-\$37.
- **QBHP (direct care staff)** full time and as needed available. Requirements include: high school education or equivalent, acceptable drug screen, acceptable background checks, computer skills, good decision making skills and the ability to multitask, while working with children and adolescents. Fulltime depends on experience and as needed starts at \$16 an hour.

The Centers for Youth and Families residential facility treats 5-17 year olds who have serious emotional and behavioral problems and have not responded to outpatient services. Clients remain at the facility typically for 3-6 months. The children attend school with us, go on outings in the community, and participate in therapeutic passes with family.
